Most onsite courses are 8:00am - 4:30pm, Webinars are two consecutive mornings.

Have available the Study Manuals, course notes, and tools including protractor, engineer's scale, straight edge or ruler, rolling ruler, calculator, stereonet, extra paper (including tracing paper), erasers, and soft lead and colored pencils. You will also find highlighters, post-its and notepaper to be helpful.

If you are taking the course as a webinar you will need to have administrator rights to the computer you will be watching on so you can join the webinar.

Before the class, it is to your benefit to review the Study Manual and work as many problems as you can at the end of the chapters, but it is not required. This will allow you the opportunity to ask questions.

Onsite courses are all day with a lunch break, Webinars are broken into two days.
